

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Monitoring Requirements Not Met For
Hardy County Public Service District
US 220 North Water System – WV3301608

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of our monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 4/1/2021 and 6/30/2021, the District sampled for TTHM's in the water system as required but the paperwork that was submitted for the sample had a minor discrepancy from the State's database resulting in the need to issue this notice.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the required monitoring and the compliance period.

What happened? What is being done?

This notice was issued due to the paperwork that was submitted to the State regarding the location where the TTHM sample was taken during the second quarter of 2021. This sample is required to be collected from a fire hydrant on Webb Lane in Old Fields. The test results from the lab stated the sample was collected at "Webb Lane Hydrant (77 Webb Lane)" rather than simply "Webb Lane Hydrant." The TTHM sample was taken at the correct time and location and the test results for the sample were well within the limits of TTHM levels but the State issued this notice because the physical address "(77 Webb Lane)" was included on the submitted form. This notice has nothing to do with water quality and was issued simply because the physical address was included on the sample location identification.
